

Requirements for International Applicants

❑ Application

Please submit the Common Application, Coalition Application, or Allegheny Application. There is no fee.

❑ High School Transcript(s)

Please also request the Common Application Mid-Year Report from your counselor once your grades are available

❑ Counselor Recommendation & School Report Form

The school report will be sent together with your recommendation.

❑ Teacher Recommendation

Only one recommendation is required. Please make sure this is in a major subject (English, biology, math, etc.).

❑ Proof of English Proficiency (for non-native English-speaking applicants)

Any of the following may be submitted as proof of English proficiency, with the appropriate scores noted:

- TOEFL IBT: score of 80
- IELTS: overall band score of 6.0
- Duolingo English Test: score of 105
- International Baccalaureate (IB) Exam: score of 5 for English A Language & Literature (HL) or English A Literature (HL)
- AP Examination score of 4 in English Language/Literature & Composition
- SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing: score of 580
- ACT (English and Reading): score of 24

The above may be waived if any of the conditions noted in the [English Waiver Form](#) are met. Please complete the form and email csegur@allegheny.edu with the subject "Allegheny College- English Waiver" to have the requirement removed.

Please make sure the bank statement(s) are dated within six months.
